

PRIDDY FOLK FESTIVAL 2024

Friday 12th July to Sunday 14th July

Craft and Trade Information

Priddy Folk Festival is held on and around Priddy Village Green. A full programme of musical and other events will be held throughout the weekend. We expect thousands of people to attend, with free public access to all the trading areas.

As in previous years, we will be concentrating the craft and trade space in a field on the left-hand side of the main road as you leave the village from the Green (opposite the main car park). To make the most of the site, we will be limiting trading to just this field with no trading on the Green itself.

Trading categorisation and prices are as follows:

- 1. Traders (in the field)
 - Sales of non-food merchandise please read important note below re. depth of pitch
 - £64 per metre of stall frontage **or** £85 per metre with power supply.
- 2. Craft Traders (in the field)
 - Sales of non-food merchandise All products must be made by the stall holder
 - £50 per metre of stall frontage **or** £71 per metre with power supply
- 3. Henna/Tattoo/Face Painting/Hair Braiding is a minimum of £200 (no power)
- 4. Craft demonstrations and registered charities (in the field)
 - Demonstrators of crafts ongoing demonstrations **no selling**
 - Free pitch limited availability and size (single days and pitch sharing may be considered). Must be manned fully and set up for main trading hours

Important information

- > All pitches are sold at a minimum 2m charge
- ➤ The maximum depth is 9m in field
- Please take into account the size of all the space you require, including the stall, camping and vehicles. If your vehicle needs to go side-on with an awning as your stall the pitch width is the larger of the two items, which is normally the width of your vehicle
- You will **not** be able to overspill in any direction. All items for sale must go behind your pitch line
- > There is no room in the new field for any drift, and there is no spare space.
- If you want to save space, we can arrange parking for your vehicle/s in a separate field.
- It is likely that stalls with less depth requested will be allocated space near the entry of the field. However, this cannot be guaranteed.
- If you require more space than usual because of these new rules, please book more frontage to compensate



Other information

- 1. As usual, we are offering discounted festival weekend tickets for traders. These are £60 per person (instead of the standard price of £120). This special price is limited to four per trader. If you are interested, please fill in the appropriate part of the form and include the correct amount in your cheque. These prices will only be available to stall holders whose application is received by 31st May 2023. You do not need to have a festival ticket to trade.
- 2. We will, as usual, have large bright banners at the entrance to the field, making the Craft and Traders area very visible and stressing that entry is free.
- 3. The traders field has lots of free festival activities a sessions tent, the dance stage, bar and the Fringe music marquee (up and coming artists).
- 4. Traders will be able to set up from 5.00pm to 7.00pm on Thursday 6th July or 11.00am to 3.00pm on Friday 7th. For safety reasons, arrivals outside these times **cannot be permitted**.
- 5. Vehicles not being used must be removed to the adjacent dedicated parking area immediately. Traders will be able to camp next to the stall so long as it fits within the space booked
- 6. On arrival, please report to the Craft and Traders field where you will be directed to your pitch. Driving on to the field is at your own risk, and we do not guarantee that a tractor will be on site to assist. Mains electricity will only be available if booked before the event.
- 7. We regret that **DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE FESTIVAL SITE OR THE CAMPING**FIELD
- 8. Any stall holder who applies under one of our trading categories and, **in our opinion**, sets up and trades under an alternative category will be asked to either pay the difference, or leave the festival with no refund available.
- 9. All rubbish must be disposed of in the appropriate bins. Recycling facilities will be available and must be used.
- 10. Pitches will not be allowed **any** music or amplified sound as this distracts from the official performances.
- 11. As part of our sustainability pledge, we would like all traders to minimise the use of plastic. All traders are being encouraged to support us in reducing, reusing and recycling as much as possible
- 12. Once booked, refunds will only be provided if a replacement stall holder can be found
